

### June 2017 - Newsletter

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Dear Neighbour,

We are fast approaching the next stage in the construction programme where we must carry out excavation works to form an access tunnel under Walker's Court at the Peter Street end.

In order to carry out these works, three options were presented to the Walker's Court businesses and Westminster City Council Highways Authority:

- 1) Close the court to pedestrian access
- 2) Install a single file, ramped bridge over the excavation
- 3) Divert all pedestrian traffic through the construction site.

The overwhelming response from all parties was to proceed with option 3 -

**Divert all pedestrian traffic through the construction site.**

This will ensure that access through Walker's Court remains and the flow to pedestrians is not restricted from Peter Street to Brewer Street along Walker's Court.

The marked up drawing on the reverse of this newsletter shows the pedestrian route that will be opened during the week commencing Monday 10 July 17 and will be in place for approximately 20 weeks.

**Progress:**

The first phase of demolition has been completed to both Brewer Street and west of Walker's Court. Concrete slabs and lining walls are now being poured into both basements.
